Youth A and Junior Lead climbers are welcome to compete in Open A, please pay for both categories when registering.

Youth B competitors who are in the Australian Youth Team can register for Open A please pay for both categories when registering.

Registration

All competitors must be current State or National members of Sport Climbing Australia.

A state level membership is \$20 SCWA get's \$10 from each membership, we purchase the podium medals for the 2 state titles from the membership fee.

SCA/SCWA membership runs from January to December the 2019 membership will give you access to all SCWA sanctioned comps during 2019.

Competitors are required to register for Lead State titles, entry fee;

Early Bird \$45 before the 8th of February

Late Rego \$60 from the 8th of Feb – 20th of Feb

Last min registration 21-23rd of February \$75

Competitors who are color blind need to notify SCWA on info@sportclimbingwa.com.au at least 1 week prior to the event.

Competition format

Climbers in Youth D will Top Rope

Climbers in Youth C will Lead Qualifiers and Lead Finals

Open C is for novice climber Top Rope.

All other categories will lead qualifiers and finals.

The qualifying round for all categories will consist of 2 none identical routes in a flash format.

Finals will be an on-sight format for the top 8 from each category. No semi finals for any category.

Youth D will have 4 none identical climbs in a single round without a final.

Rules and Regulations

An attempt shall be deemed to have started, and measurement of the climbing time shall start, when every part of the competitor's body has left the ground

b) Competitors will receive 1 attempt per climb only in all rounds

- c) Scoring in Qualifications will be done in accordance to the hold number a climber reaches and/or controls, a "+" being recorded where a hold is reached but not controlled
- d) Scoring for Semi-Final and Final rounds will include the time taken for a competitor to complete their climb. In case of tied points time will be used to separate competitors
- e) An attempt on a route shall be considered successful if the route has been climbed in accordance with the rules and if the rope has been clipped into the karabiner on the final quickdraw of the route (or two hands are placed on the final hold of a top rope climb for 3 seconds) within the fixed time period for attempts.
- f) The attempt of a competitor on a route shall be considered unsuccessful if the

competitor:

- i. Falls.
- ii. Exceeds the fixed climbing time for the route.
- iii. Returns to the ground with any part of the body after having started their attempt.
- iv. Uses any part of the wall, holds or features that are deemed out of bounds or not allowable.
- g) The fixed length of the climbing period in the Qualification round shall be six (6) minutes for each route.
- h) The fixed length of the climbing period in the Finals rounds shall be eight (8) minutes for each route

Finals Procedure

- a) The top 8 climbers from the combined score of the qualifier rounds have an on-sight final.
- b) During the final competitors must remain within a designated Isolation Zone until their turn to climb. Unauthorized personnel are not permitted to enter the Isolation Zone.
- c) A collective observation period for all finalists shall be held immediately prior to the

commencement of the finals round.

d) Climbers are escorted by an official to the Competition Area. Whilst in the Competition Area, competitors are not permitted to seek any information from persons outside the Competition Area (e.g. members of the public, coaches etc.).
